How to use the BCT's Credit Offer Portal

Before you submit your Credit Offer application

Important things to know before submitting your bids online

1. Search the Wanted Credits List using all four credit class attributes of the credits you own

Search the Wanted Credits List for **the credit class you own (or propose to create).** For species credits, simply enter the species name (common or scientific) of the credits you own (or propose to create) and select the search button. For ecosystem credits, enter the <u>four</u> credit class attributes that identify the credits you own (or propose to create):

- IBRA subregion
- PCT ID
- Offset Trading Group
- Hollow-bearing tree status.

In past tenders, a large proportion of bids were ineligible because one credit class attribute did not match the credit owner or landholder's credit class. You will not benefit from submitting bids for credit class options that don't match the four credit class attributes of your credits. In most cases these bids will be ineligible. If the BCT wants your credits, the specific credit class of your credits will be displayed in the Wanted Credits List. If the specific credit class you own is not displayed, then unfortunately the BCT is not seeking your credits at this time.

Common examples of ineligible bids and an exception for Threatened Ecological Community credits are outlined in the Participants' Guide.

2. Take screenshots of your credit offers

Take and save screen shots of the credits and prices offered in each of your applications, as currently our system does not provide you with a summary of your credit offer application details. We are working hard to improve the system's functionality for future tenders.

3. Business case requirements for proposed credits

A Business case (or a draft or finalised BSSAR) needs to be submitted with a bid for proposed credits. The purpose of the Business case is to assist the landholder in making an informed decision on proceeding with a BSA and the price at which credits can be sold. It also allows the BCT to make sure it's not committing to purchase credits that are unlikely to be delivered and so preventing other participants from having the opportunity to sell these credits.

Business cases must be prepared by an accredited assessor and must include the following information to be eligible:

- 1. Name of assessor and accreditation number.
- 2. Map of PCTs on the proposed BSA site that has been ground-truthed through an on-site assessment.
- 3. Preliminary map of vegetation zones (note that a map of management zones is not required).
- 4. Estimate of the number of ecosystem credits expected to be created in each vegetation zone (or management zone where relevant) based on BAM plot data collected from the site. Credit information must include the IBRA subregion, PCT ID, Offset Trading Group and Hollow-Bearing Tree status.
- 5. For applications for species credits, confirmed presence of the species on the site and an estimate of the number of credits expected to be created.
- 6. Total Fund Deposit (TFD) estimate for the site.

The BCT will only accept the bid as eligible if sufficient evidence is provided to support the above requirements. The BCT may at its discretion, seek additional information or clarification on any bid during the assessment process, however it is not required to do so.

Biodiversity offset program

The Biodiversity Offsets Scheme (BOS) is a framework to avoid, minimise and offset impacts on biodiversity from development and clearing, and to ensure land that is used to offset impacts is secured in-perpetuity. The scheme consists of two elements:

- Developers and landholders who undertake development or clearing, generating a credit obligation which must be retired to offset their activity
- Landholders who establish a biodiversity stewardship site on their land, through Biodiversity Stewardship Agreements (BSA), generating credits to sell to developers or landholders who require those credits, to securely offset activities at other sites.

The purpose of the Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT) is to seek strategic biodiversity offset outcomes under the BOS to compensate for the loss of biodiversity due to development and other activities. The BCT has a strategic goal to deliver a strategic biodiversity offsetting service to the developers and landholders of NSW.

The BCT works to achieve this goal by delivering the Biodiversity Offsets Program (BOP). Under the BOP, the BCT secures biodiversity offsets on behalf of developers who opt to pay into the Biodiversity Conservation Fund to meet NSW state and Commonwealth offset obligations of their development approval.



Ecosystem Credits (Table 1)

Search for ecosystem credits wanted by the BCT by answering four questions at the top of the table. The questions require the following information on your credits:

- the IBRA subregion where the credits come from (or are proposed to be created)
- the Plant Community Type (PCT)
- the Offset Trading Group of the credits Offset Trading Groups are groups of credit types that have similar characteristics, and
- the presence or absence of hollow-bearing trees.

For existing credit owners, this information is provided on the credit report or, for BBAM credits, on the statement of reasonable credit equivalence.

For interested landholders, this information is provided in a feasibility assessment prepared by an accredited assessor. New landholders who do not have a feasibility assessment can find out how to get started here.

The questions at the top of the table allows you to filter the list of ecosystem credits to see if the BCT wants the credits you have available. If the BCT does want your credits, the Wanted Credit List will identify the number of BAM credits the BCT is seeking to purchase. If the BCT doesn't want your credits the search results will be empty.

Note that the search results for different filter questions cannot be combined or added. For example, the number of credits with a status of 'Hollow-bearing tree – Present' and 'Hollow-bearing tree – Absent' can't be added together. This is because the BCT has already considered these combinations when determining the number of wanted credits.
