The BCT supports hundreds of landholders, farmers and conservation organisations to protect, connect and restore biodiversity on private land.

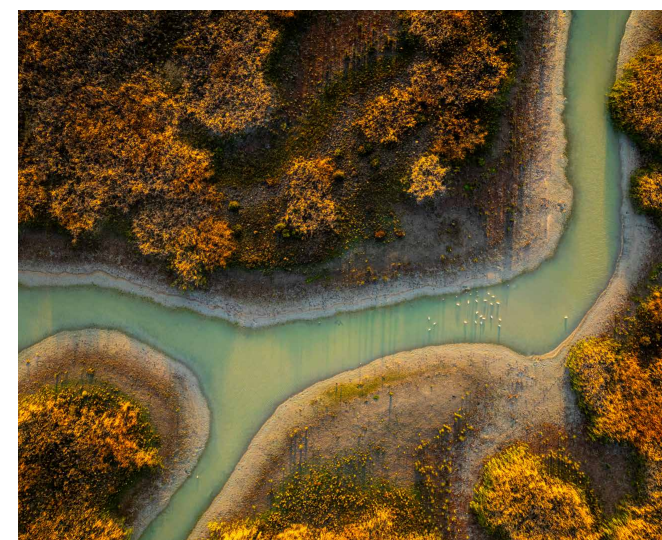
We are Australia's only agency that offers in-perpetuity funded conservation agreements to landholders.

We are guided by a scientifically based government-approved investment strategy.

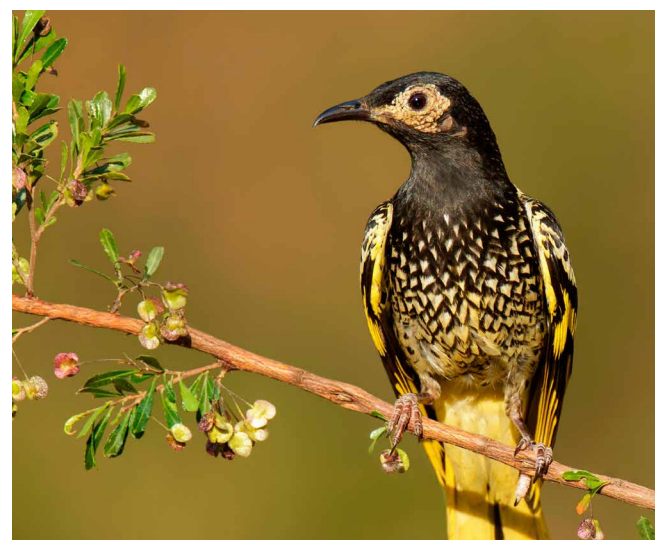
Our ecological monitoring program is accredited by Accounting for Nature and measures effectiveness, biodiversity gains and ecological outcomes at site, region and state scales.

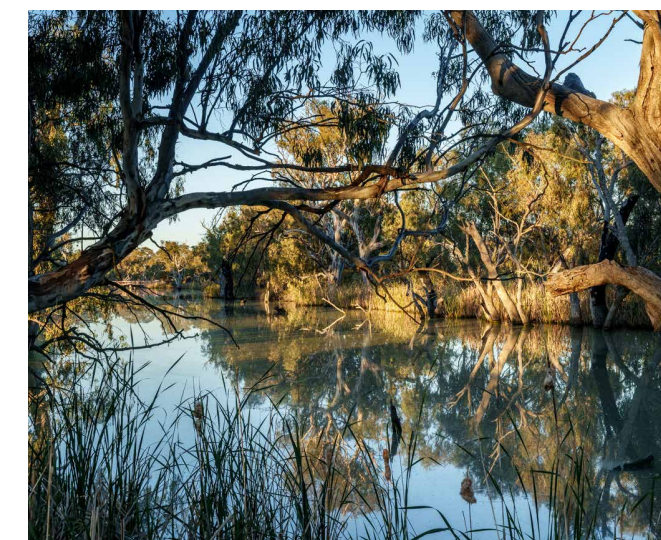
Cultural Biodiversity Conservation

Partner on our initiatives to enable caring for Country with Aboriginal landholders.



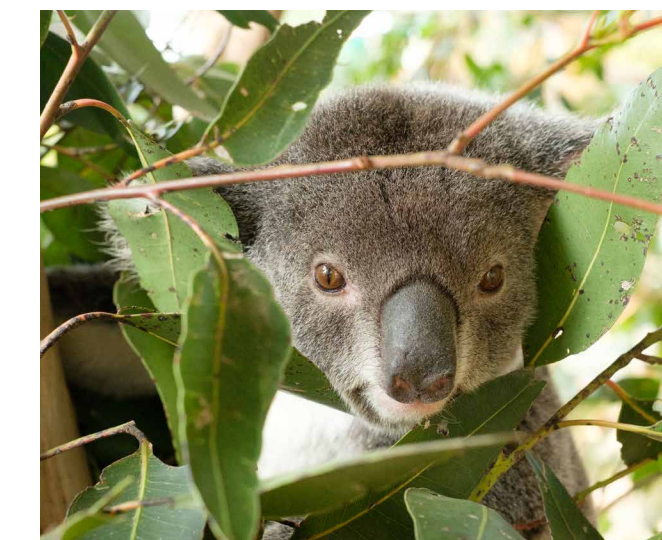
Conservation Management Program

Conservation Co-investment

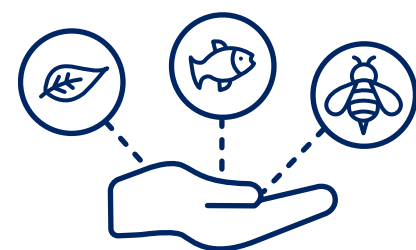

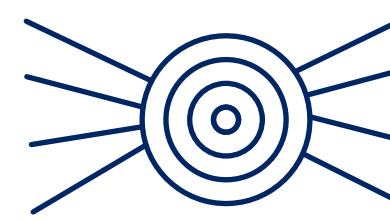

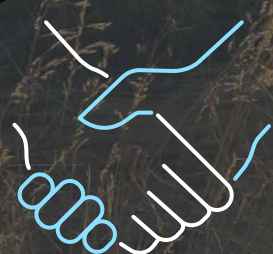
Everlasting impact

A trusted network

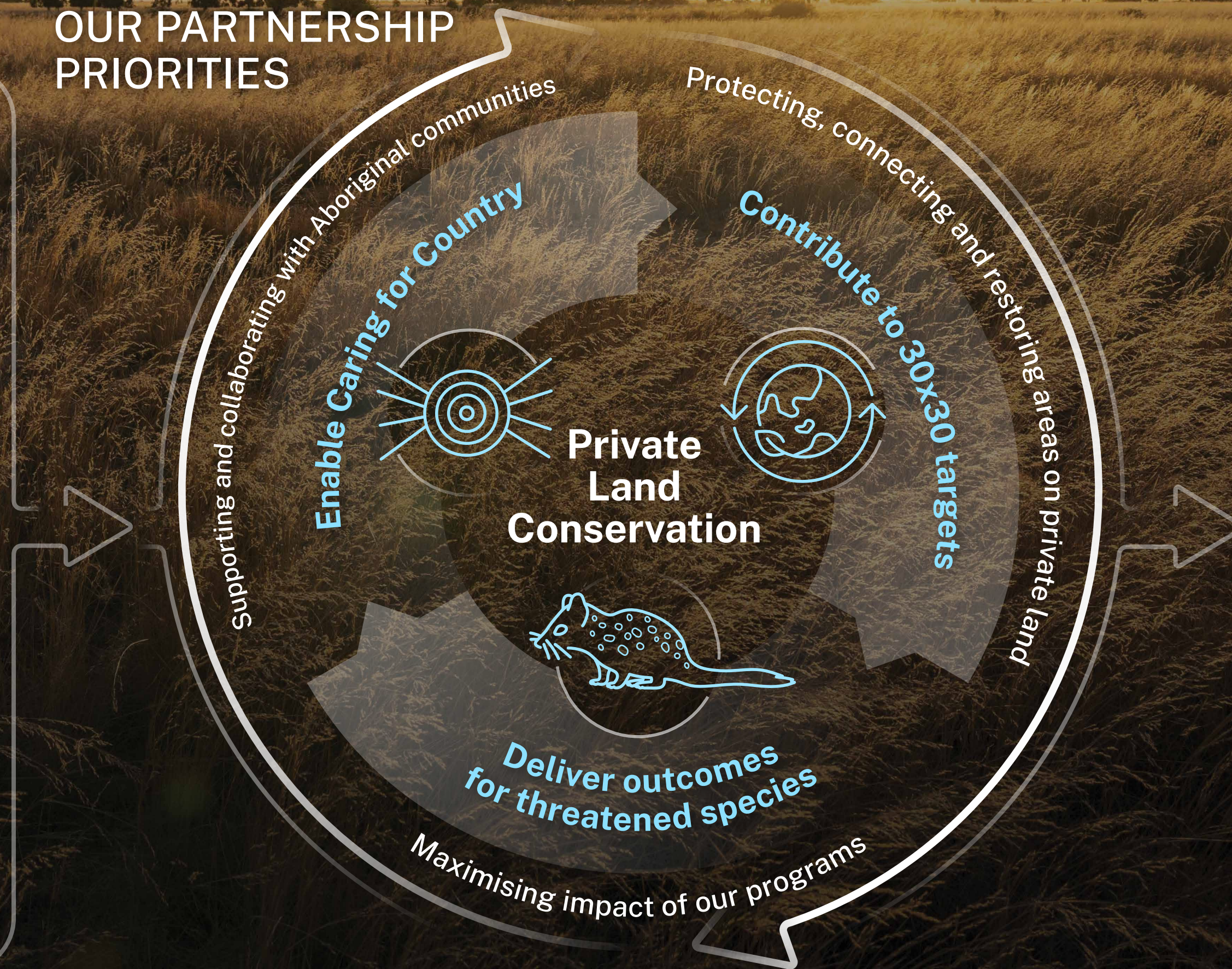
An existing network of over 2300 land stewards, supported by local expert staff who live and work in our regions.
